KCC Trading Standards has been made aware of a man claiming to be from Trading Standards.

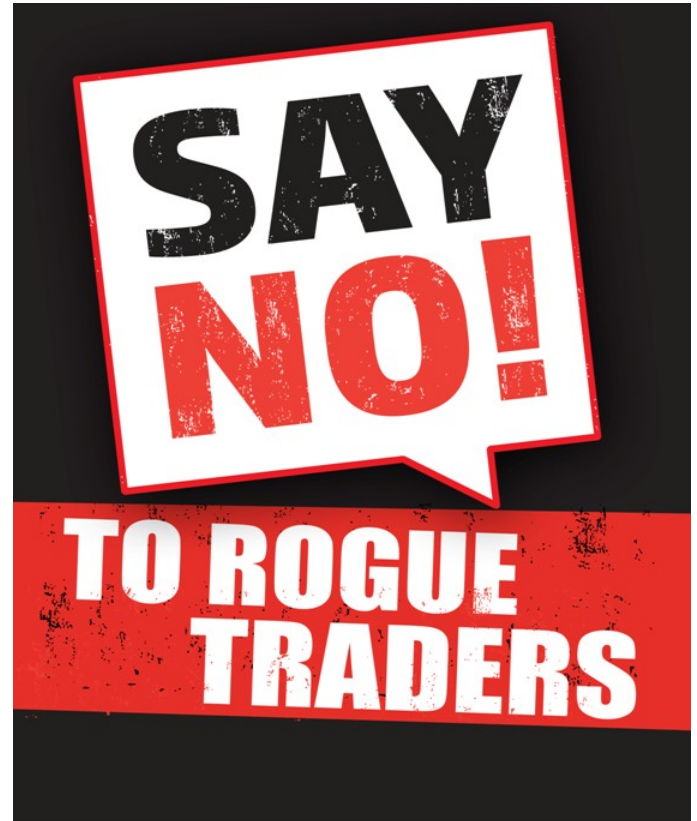
The man, using the name 'Chris Pack', approached an elderly lady in Birchington about the building work she was having done and attempted to get money from her.

Trading Standards Officers always carry ID. If someone claims to be from Trading Standards ask for their ID.
